Classroom

The lab is spacious and well ventilated.

Safa Public School provides GPS fitted transport facility for students, and the students are accompanied by a helper. The school has a fleet of buses which ply on different routes. Each bus is equipped with a first aid kit. Safety and punctuality is top priority and the school does not compromise in any way on it. All steps are taken to make the journey to and fro smooth and secure.



ADMISSION NORMS

- ❖ Children will be admitted to different classes according to the prescribed age and their performance in admission test in English, Hindi, Maths & Science.
- ❖ Children of three years are admitted in Nursery Class.
- ❖ Parents/Guardians are required to fill up the prescribed Admission Form which can be obtained at the school office or can be downloaded from school website.
- ❖ Three recent passport-size photographs of the student will be required for Admission Form, Identity card etc. and a family photograph for admission form.
- ❖ Supporting documents as listed in the Admission Form must be submitted along with the form.

FEE NORMS

- ❖ Fee for a particular month must be paid by 10th of that month to avoid fine. If the fee is not paid by the end of the month, name of the student will be struck off from the school records.
- ❖ If more than two child of a parent are studying, the child of the lower class will get a sibling concession. It will however stand applicable on filling "sibling concession form" available at the school counter.
- ❖ Fees once paid will be Non-Refundable.
- ❖ School fee can be revised any time without assigning any reason.
- ❖ Fees for the full session will be payable even in case of late admissions.

EXAMINATION RULES

- ❖ The Test & Exam dates are provided well in advance through the school planner.
- ❖ Question papers are prepared as per CBSE guidelines.
- ❖ The students shall appear in all Examinations as per the given schedule. No application or excuse for change in the date will be entertained.
- ❖ No leave other than the medical leave is sanctioned during the tests. Application for medical leave should be duly supported by a medical certificate from a registered MBBS doctor.
- ❖ Medical certificate should be submitted well in time to make appropriate entries in the school record.
- ❖ Absence due any other reason will not be taken into consideration in determining the promotion.
- ❖ Adopting unfair means during an examination will attract deterrent punishment.
- ❖ It is mandatory for every student to have a minimum 75% over all average attendance to appear in final exams.

PROMOTION RULES

- ❖ Promotion to the next class is based on the annual aggregate of 33% marks. Pass marks in each subject is 33%.
- ❖ The school does not undertake to retain answer-scripts for more than a month after the reports are given.
- ❖ Internal re-checks, totaling of the marks etc. will be completed by a scheme of standardization before reports are given out. Hence as a general rule, no answer-scripts will be shown to parents.
- ❖ In case of any complaint of injustice the same can be brought to the notice of the Principal and she/he at her/his sole discretion may have the answer scripts re-checked.
- ❖ Promotion once refused will not be considered. In no case shall a student be promoted on trial.
- ❖ A student who has not appeared for all the test papers and has not completed all the two terminal examinations of the academic year either due to medical leave or leave taken at own risk, will not be considered for rank in the class.

DISCIPLINARY RULES

- ❖ Cell phone or other electronic gadgets are not allowed in school.
- ❖ Students must not loiter recklessly and are prohibited to visit the staff-room without permission.
- ❖ Students must not indulge in any act, which is subversive to law and order.
- ❖ They must be polite, soft spoken, friendly and cooperative among themselves and maintain decorum in and outside the school.
- ❖ They must strictly observe silence, avoid acts of rowdiness and maintain high discipline in their manners, conduct and behavior.
- ❖ Students found involved in any misconduct, would be liable to punishment and deterrent action may be taken against them, leading to their expulsion and rustication.
- ❖ No child is allowed to drive any motor vehicle/bike to school. Any such case shall be strictly dealt with.

WITHDRAWAL, LONG ABSENCE, RE-ADMISSION

- ❖ One month's notice of withdrawal must be given in writing. School dues are to be paid in full.
- ❖ No dues certificate must be obtained from the school office before a T.C. is issued.
- ❖ In case of a student who has attended school at the commencement of the session, or thereafter, Transfer Certificate shall be issued to him/her only on payment of six months' fee. Also, if a student withdraws his/her name in the middle of the session, Transfer Certificate shall be issued to him/her on clearance of all the dues of the current session.
- ❖ If any child is absent without information for a long time, his/her name will be struck off after a period of 30 days.
- ❖ If a child is re-admitted, full admission fee will be charged.

PARENTAL CO-OPERATION

- ❖ Parents are requested to pay school fees on time.
- ❖ They are requested to send their ward regularly and punctually to school in the prescribed uniform with books and stationery as prescribed by the school.
- ❖ If due to unavoidable reasons, their wards cannot attend school, they must send leave application within three days. However, they are requested not to send sick students to school. After reaching school, they will not be allowed to go home.
- ❖ They are requested to sign the school diaries of their wards daily to ensure that their wards are doing their work regularly..
- ❖ They are requested to sign sheets and the Progress Reports of their action to remove deficiency, if any.
- ❖ They are requested to encourage their wards to participate in all school activities.
- ❖ They are requested to avoid criticism of teachers in the presence of their wards.
- ❖ To discuss the progress and problems of their wards, they may see the Principal on any working day.
- ❖ They may see teachers with the permission of the principal. However, they are not allowed.
- ❖ IN PARENT TEACHER MEETING (PTM) are planned where parents get platform to share their views and concerns about the child. The teachers also get an opportunity to speak to the parents in the presence of their child, as special time slots are allotted for each child. So every parent must attend their wards PTM.

RULES OF THE HOSTEL

1. Hostel students will follow strictly the daily routine of the Hostel and School, unless exempted on medical grounds on the recommendation of the Hostel Warden/doctor.
2. They are not allowed to stay in the dormitory during school hours/games/activity/ study time. They are not allowed to keep or take medicines or tonic without the knowledge of the Hostel Warden. Any Medicines must be handed over to the Warden concerned
3. Mobiles & Electronic gadgets with external speakers ARE NOT PERMITTED .
4. The school will not be responsible for the loss of any cash/property of the student
5. Hostel students will be allowed to go home during the long and short breaks. The Local guardians/parents will collect the child from the school . All boards will return to the hostel a day before the school reopens (5p.m). A fine of Rs. 500/- will be imposed for late arrival. Furthermore, the school reserves the right to terminate the hostel admission of any student not reporting back in time.
6. Any willful damage to or theft of School property or other's property will be regarded as a breach of School/Hostel rules and the student would be fined by School Authorities.
7. The child has to compulsorily participate in co-curricular Activities, games and sport
8. Any inquiries regarding their wards by parents must be made only to the Warden concerned. Specially. Contacting any other Hostel staff is prohibited
9. Boarders are provided with a bed. a cupboard. a Study unit and a chair. Each boarder must maintain with utmost cleanliness and make sure the floor under his/her bed and cupboard is clean. Waste paper and refuse must be thrown in dustbins only
10. Surprise checks will be made by Hostel Warden, Principal & Director. Any extra items, other than those specified in the hostel kit will be confiscated.
11. Parents or visitors are not permitted to enter the hostel under any circumstances, except the visiting room area specially designated for meeting their wards.
12. When hostellers are unable to return on time after a weekends & holiday, leave letters should be sent to the warden by the local guardian within 24 hours.
13. All Hostel students of the school treated in outside for any illness are required to bring a fitness certificate before joining the hostel. Only then will they be allowed to re-join the hostel.
14. Notice of withdrawal must be given within 30 days of the last date of the term. Tuition fees have to be paid for the entire period including notice period. Full fees would be charged for shorter period of notice.
15. If a Boarder is withdrawn from the hostel, full fees have to be paid.
16. In the case of non-payment of fees installments, the Boarders name will be struck off the hostel rolls after a month and it would be treated as a case of automatic withdrawal from the hostel.
17. Boarders must spend the minimum time required in bathrooms and toilets to give others a fair chance to use them. They must ensure that the bathrooms and toilets, after use, are as clean as they would like to find them. They must also make sure that they close all the taps.
18. All meals will be eaten in the dining hall. After meals chairs/benches must be put back neatly in order.
19. Health laws require that no one but authorized personnel is permitted in the kitchen.

20. Keep the plates in the designated place. Food, Dishes, Silverware, etc. not to be removed from the dining hall or kitchen.

21. All students should stay out of the dining hall except during MEAL/ PERMITTED TIME

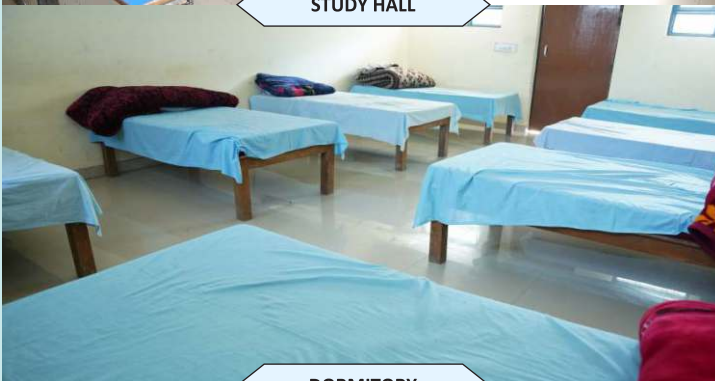
